The two women screamed and also fell, and one of the dogs bit Bob on his hand. It was chaos. Three people were tangled up on the ground with two barking dogs. Bob's knees and hand were bleeding.

After the situation had finally calmed down, Bob slowly limped home. He felt a lot of pain in his knees, so walking was difficult. When he was a few hundred meters from his house, it suddenly started raining hard. He arrived at his home about 10 minutes later, wet and bloody.
