Chinese officials look to limit social media and screen time in China

WASHINGTON – While some young people in China admit to spending too much time online, many are unsure about new government ideas aimed at cutting down their internet and social media use.

During China’s recent political meetings in Beijing, retired basketball star Yao Ming spoke in favor of limiting internet use for young people. He suggested that students turn off all electronic devices for one full day each school semester and spend time outside being active. Government officials also called for more rules on online gaming and warned that too much internet use could hurt the health and school performance of children under 18.

China already has some of the world’s strictest internet rules, blocking many websites and foreign social media apps. Still, the country has a huge and very active online population.

Some people on Chinese social media supported the new plans, but many others shared complaints. They pointed out problems – such as the fact that students are in school most of the day and need the internet to do their homework. “Schools should give less homework that requires... online research,” wrote one user from Hebei Province. “Minors get home around 9 or 10 p.m., so when do they even have time to use social media?” asked another user from Beijing.

A college student in Beijing, who spoke with VOA* but did not want her name used because the topic is sensitive, agreed that internet overuse is a problem, but she didn’t think Yao’s idea would help much.

“Chinese teenagers are really hooked on the internet. You see people walking around

staring at their phones. We use the internet for almost everything,” she said. “I don’t think limits like this will help. It’s hard to stop something you’re used to. How can one ‘no-internet day’ fix this?”

According to the *2024 China Game Industry Minor Protection Report*, as of December 2023, China had 196 million internet users under age 18. Around 97.3% of young people have internet access.

Will Wang, a Chinese student studying in the U.S., said that when he goes back to Beijing during school holidays, he sees how much people use the internet every day. “There’s clearly a big rise in screen use for all ages,” Wang said in a written message to VOA. “Many teens are always using TikTok, RedNote, Bilibili, and other websites.”

He added that the internet gives young people a bit of personal space, which is rare in their busy lives. “Most teens don’t have much private time at home or school. The internet is often their only way to relax. Nearly every kid has extra classes or study time after school,” Wang said. “The internet helps them stay in touch with friends and the world.”

Xu Quan, a media writer based in Hong Kong, said the internet can even help children cope with* stress from school or parents. “Some people think it’s a bad thing, but the internet helps kids deal with pressure. Taking it away might hurt their mental and physical health,” he said.

These new ideas come after earlier steps to control youth internet use. In 2020, China updated its *Law on the Protection of Minors*, telling websites for gaming, social media, and live streaming to add features that help stop overuse.

In 2021, the government made strong rules about gaming time for minors. Kids under 18 were banned from playing between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. They were only allowed to play one hour a day on weekdays and two hours a day on weekends. During this year’s Chinese New Year holiday, Tencent Games gave minors just 15 total hours of play time over the 32-day break. But many kids can still get around these rules by using adult accounts.

A Qiang, who used to work in Chinese media, said he doesn't believe the political meetings in Beijing will bring real change. He thinks the real problem is not too much online freedom – but not enough freedom in real life. “The issue isn't that young people have too much time online,” he said. “It's that they don't have enough time or space to enjoy life outside the internet.”
